2. Courses

The courses offered by the École nationale supérieure d'art et de design de Limoges are divided into first-level courses, lasting three years, and second-level courses, lasting two years.

In general, we prefer to integrate students on Erasmus mobility programmes into the second year so that they can benefit from all the workshops. The third year is a final year of study, with the 4th and 5th years working on a project that is already well developed. However, depending on the student's level and the progress of their project, they will be able to take part in workshops and courses in other years.

3.2. Application process

The sending institution must forward to josiane.pradoux@ensad.limoges.fr the official nominations before May 15th for the autumn semester and befor October 15th for the spring semester.

After being nominated by their home institution, students must forward to josiane.pradoux@ensad.limoges.fr the following documents:

- Application form
- Artistic portfolio
- Learning Agreement
- ID copy
- french B2 certification or self-certification (a written document signed by the student in which they declare their level in french language)

The professors coordinators of the departments will review applications, and student will be accepted depending on the quality of their work and the places available in each department or group.

The ENSAD Limoges will send the student a response by email within a month after the nomination deadline.
